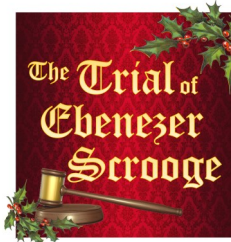

The Trial of the Century! A year

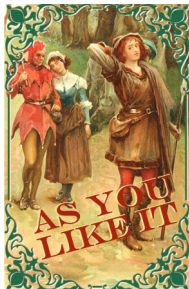
