Background Required and Qualifications

- Must have experience teaching in the content area assigned and/or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

- Has the ability to work with others.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

- Works collaboratively with appropriate camp staff on the content of the instructional program and related activities.
- Provides a teaching plan or class outline, with handouts, for assigned classes that adhere to the theme and overall plan for the camp week.
- Prepares and leads each session for the assigned area.
- Works closely, cooperatively and amicably with other staff members.
- Notifies the Education Director if he/she must be absent or late for duty for any reason.
- Reports problems and seek advice from the Education Director when needed.
- Reports all difficulties related to health of the campers immediately to a Lead Counselor or MAC Office Staff.
- Stimulates campers' interest in individual and group activities.
- Provides a safe learning environment to motivate youth.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
