**General Job Description:**

The Theatre Education Internship is a position that will provide the opportunity to learn administrative, collaboration, and leadership skills. This position is heavily student facing and a dedication to creating a welcoming and inclusive learning environment for everyone is of the utmost importance. Every member of the MAC team has a willingness to learn, as well as a commitment to a safe and equitable work environment. This position reports to the Director of Theatre Education. Additional duties are listed below.

**Job Duties:**

- Assist with the planning and leading of daily activities, games, and programs.
- Supervise and mentor students throughout the production and rehearsal process.
- Follow and enforce all MACademy policies and procedures.
- Participate in production meetings and training sessions.
- Assist in maintaining an environment that is conducive to promoting learning.
- Communicate clearly and respectfully to students, fellow teaching artists, staff, and teachers, and share questions, comments, or concerns with the Director of Theatre Education as needed.
- Assist in keeping designated teaching areas clean and safe.
- Other duties as assigned

**Qualifications:**

- Must be currently enrolled in high school or college, and have experience in theatre of performing arts.
- Excellent interpersonal skills, including communication, teamwork, and collaboration with others.

- Willingness to develop leadership skills and ability to work in a team environment.
- Positive attitude, responsible, dependable, and punctual.
